



MEET THE RAINBOW SERPENT

Join our wonderful wildlife ambassadors in this exploration of the deep culture of the traditional custodians of the land we live on here in Australia. Aboriginal people have cared for their environment for 100,000 years. Learn about how they live alongside the land, about their totem animals, be absorbed in dreamtime stories and examine which animals they depended upon for their survival. Meet a possum, red-tailed black cockatoo, turtle, blue tongue, goanna, woma python, saltwater crocodile and even the majestic rainbow serpent.
